Primary Care Provider

Your first stop for most healthcare and the best place to go for non-emergency care



- Wellness or Preventive Visits
- Chronic Condition Management
- Vaccinations
- Fever, Flu, Cough, Ear Pain
- Abdominal Pain
- Nausea, Vomiting, Diarrhea

- Minor Burns
- Cuts, Scrapes, Minor Bleeding
- Minor Allergic Reaction
- Nosebleed
- Headache/Migraine
- Urinary Tract Infection

Urgent Care

If your primary care doctor is unavailable and you cannot or should not wait

- Abdominal Pain
- Burns
- Cuts that require stitches
- Flu Symptoms (sudden fever, cough, congestion, body aches)
- Fractures and Sprains
- High Fever
- Minor Injuries
- Rashes and Hives
- Vomiting or Diarrhea

Emergency Room

Treatment is needed immediately for serious life-threatening illness or injury



- Heart S.T.O.P. Symptoms
- F.A.S.T Stroke Symptoms
- Uncontrolled Bleeding
- Complex Fractures
- Coughing or Vomiting Blood
- Seizures
- Sudden Loss of Consciousness or Ability to Move
- Difficulty Breathing
- Poison Ingestion
